



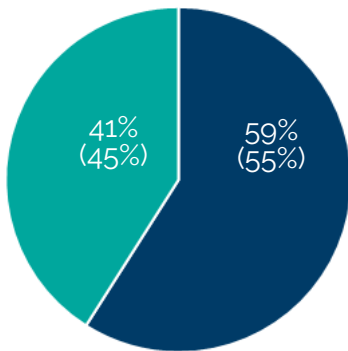

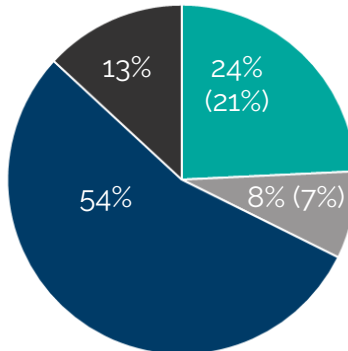

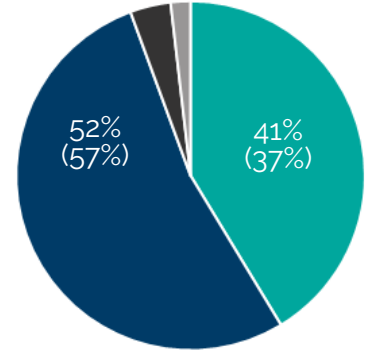

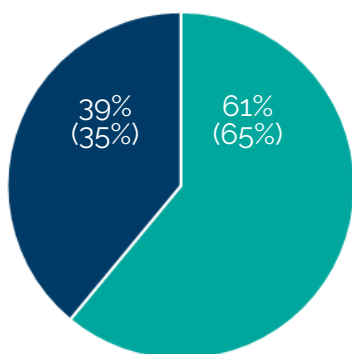

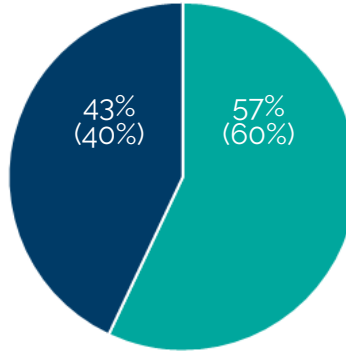

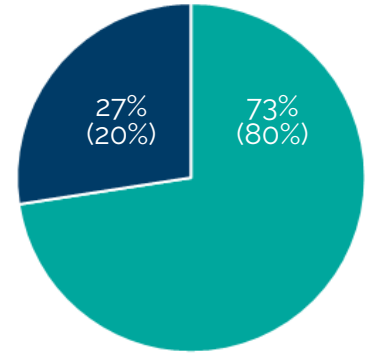

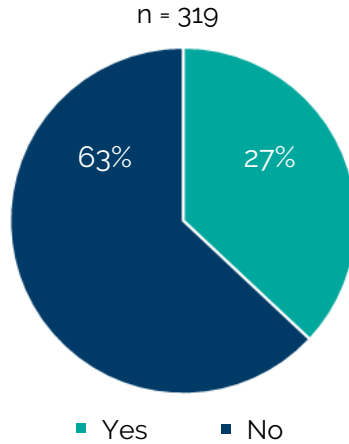

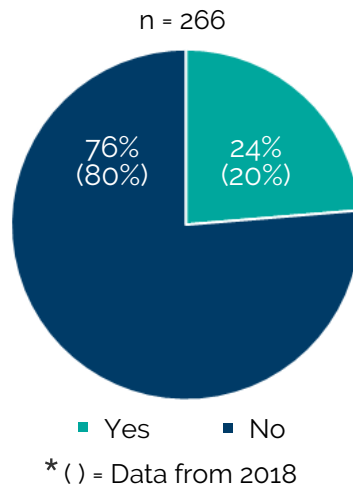
# Point in Time Homeless Count- 2019
