Successful Permanent Housing Outcomes

Draft Target: 60%

FY 2017

> 44% of households served by shelters, transitional housing programs, and rapid re-housing programs left homelessness at the end of the program for a permanent housing destination

FY 2018 Draft

▶ 41.5% of households served by shelters, transitional housing programs, and rapid re-housing programs left homelessness at the end of the program for a permanent housing destination

Length of Time Homeless

Draft Target: 10% decrease, to 67 days

FY 2017

On average, people experienced homelessness in Delaware for 75

days before returning to stable permanent housing

Returns to Homelessness

Draft Target: decrease rate of returns to 20%

FY 2017

▶ 22% of people that left homelessness for permanent housing returned within 2 years

FY 2018 Draft

▶ 23% of people that left homelessness for permanent housing returned within 2 years

First Time Homeless

Draft Target: 10% decrease

FY 2017

> 78% of people who experienced homeless were homeless for the first time (in 2 years)

▶ 2,836 people

FY 2018 Draft

> 68% of people who experienced homeless were homeless for the first time (in 2 years)
